

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE BUDGET MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 12, 2022**

Pro-tem Chairman Steve Briske called the Budget Meeting to order at 8:46 p.m. Notice of said meeting was published in the Nebraska Signal on August 31, 2022, and posted in three public places within the Village of Milligan one week prior to the budget hearing. Present were board members S. Briske, D. Kotas, L. Steuben and K. Gurley. Absent: E. Milton. Also present were V. Thompson, Clerk, J. Zelenka, maintenance, and Todd Blome of BMG Certified Public Accountants.

L. Steuben moved, seconded by D. Kotas to increase the restricted funds allocation by 1%. Roll call vote: Ayes: S. Briske, D. Kotas, L. Steuben and K. Gurley. Nays: none. Motion carried.

D. Kotas moved, seconded by L. Steuben to adopt the 2022-2023 budget as presented. Roll call vote: Ayes: S. Briske, D. Kotas, L. Steuben and K. Gurley. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Pro-tem Chairman S. Briske introduced the following Resolution 2022-02:

“WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1632 and 77-1633 provides that the Governing Body of the Village of Milligan, Nebraska passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the Village of Milligan, Nebraska, resolves that:

1. The 2022-2023 property tax request for general purposes be set at \$73,589.62.
2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year’s total assessed value by 2.85%.
3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be \$0.437534 per \$100 of assessed value.
4. The Village of Milligan proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$0.45 per \$100 of assessed value.
5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of the Village of Milligan will increase (or decrease) last year’s budget by 116.16%.
6. A copy of this resolution be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk prior to October 15, 2022.”

D. Kotas moved, seconded by K. Gurley to adopt Resolution No. 2022-02. Roll call vote: Ayes: S. Briske, D. Kotas, L. Steuben and K. Gurley. Nays: none. Motion carried.

L. Steuben moved, seconded by K. Gurley, to close the budget meeting at 8:55 p.m. Roll call vote: Ayes: S. Briske, D. Kotas, L. Steuben and K. Gurley. Nays: none. Motion carried.
