The Milligan Public Library Board met January 13, 2025 at the Milligan Village Board room. The meeting of January 6<sup>th</sup> had been canceled due to bad weather.

A meeting notice was posted in the window of the library ten days in advance of the meeting.

President, Mary Johnson called the meeting to order at 3:30 PM. Present were Mary Johnson, President; Shirley Brunkow, Treasurer; Dorothy Novak, Secretary; Director, Beth Vavra; and Lois Kotas, Librarian; absent was Mary E. Uldrich, Director.


Lois has been ordering new books and supplies from Amazon.
