

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE BUDGET HEARING  
SEPTEMBER 13, 2021**

Pro-tem Chairman Steve Briske called the Budget Hearing to order at 8:32 p.m. Notice of said hearing was published in the Nebraska Signal on September 1, 2021, and posted in three public places within the Village of Milligan one week prior to the budget hearing. Present were board members E. Milton, S. Briske, L. Steuben and K. Gurley. Absent: D. Kotas. Also present were V. Thompson, Clerk, J. Zelenka, maintenance, and Todd Blome of BMG Certified Public Accountants.

Todd Blome of BMG Certified Public Accountants presented the budget for 2021-2022. Blome discussed several aspects of the budget and answered questions from the Board. No public comments were received.

K. Gurley moved, seconded by L. Steuben to increase the restricted funds allocation by 1%. Roll call vote: Ayes: E. Milton, S. Briske, L. Steuben and K. Gurley. Nays: none. Motion carried.

L. Steuben moved, seconded by K. Gurley to adopt the 2021-2022 budget as presented. Roll call vote: Ayes: E. Milton, S. Briske, L. Steuben and K. Gurley. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Pro-tem Chairman S. Briske introduced the following Resolution 2021-03:

“WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1601.02 provides that the Governing Body of the Village of Milligan, Nebraska passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the Village of Milligan, Nebraska, resolves that:

1. The 2020-2021 property tax request for general purposes be set at \$71,551.00.
2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 13.13%.
3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be \$0.436326 per \$100 of assessed value.
4. The Village of Milligan proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$0.449995 per \$100 of assessed value.
5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of the Village of Milligan will increase last year's budget by 5.52%.
6. A copy of this resolution be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk prior to October 13, 2021.”

L. Steuben moved, seconded by K. Gurley to adopt Resolution No. 2021-03. Roll call vote: Ayes: E. Milton, S. Briske, L. Steuben and K. Gurley. Nays: none. Motion carried.

L. Steuben moved, seconded by K. Gurley, to close the budget hearing at 8:55 p.m. Roll call vote: Ayes: E. Milton, S. Briske, L. Steuben and K. Gurley. Nays: none. Motion carried.
