

September 22, 2020

The Milligan Library Board met September 22, 2020 at the Village Board room.

Present were Shirley Brunkow, Treasurer; Dorothy Novak, Secretary; Donna Krupicka, Director; Marv Johnson, Director. Absent was Kathy Rischling, President.

In the absence of the President, Marv called the meeting to order at 1:45.

The minutes of the June 22, 2020 meeting were read and a motion was made by Shirley to approve the minutes as read. Motion was seconded by Donna.

The Treasurer's report was given by Shirley, with Dorothy making the motion to approve the report and Donna seconded the motion. The report was placed on file.

Old Business:

A discussion was held about having the children's story time. But because of the Covid-19 virus, it was decided that story time will not be held at this time.

Shirley reported there is a Certificate of Deposit that will be maturing soon and the board decided to let it roll over to another term as the money is not needed at this time.

New Business:

Shirley reported that recently the library had been without internet service, a technician was called and corrected the problem.

After a discussion it was decided not to participate in the Trunk or Treat Halloween event this year.

Marv received some information about the library becoming a Certified Library but as there are a number of qualifications that we cannot meet no further action will be taken.

A staff person from the Fillmore County Senior Services will again be at the library to assist residents with their Medicare drug plan options for the next year. Appointments are to be made for the dates of October 15, 28, and November 18.

Shirley reported that the usual library patrons are checking out three or four books at a time and not coming as often due to the virus. A number of new books were requested and are available to be checked out.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:15
