

Milligan Public Library Board Meeting, March 21, 2022

The Milligan Public Library board met at the library March 21, 2022.

President, Mary Johnson called the meeting to order at 5:30. Those present were: President, Mary Johnson; Treasurer, Shirley Brunkow; Secretary, Dorothy Novak and Directors, Beth Vavra and Crystal Vavra.

Shirley reported that there still is poor attendance at the childrens' story time with three children attending. She will continue with story time until this school term ends and then make a decision about having it when school starts in the fall.

Crystal brought the Santa Mail Box and forms that will be used in writing to the children. The mailbox will located in the library after Thanksgiving with Crystal being charge of the project. Beth made a motion to pay Crystal for these items and Shirley seconded the motion.

There was a short discussion about having a Woman's Book Club with Beth and Crystal sharing their experiences.

New Business:

Shirley is making a list of supplies needed at the library and will be purchasing these.

It was suggested that a quilt be placed in the library window for June Jubilee to attract attention to the library. Shirley suggested placing a number of quilts made by story time children in the past, this was met with unanimous agreement.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:15. The next meeting will be June 27, 2022 at the library.
