The annual Halloween Trunk or Treat event will be held on Sunday this year and Shirley will be at the library to hand out treats to the children. Mary made a motion and Donna seconded the motion to reimburse Shirley for the expense of the treats.

Old Business:

The shelving was delivered and again was the wrong size, the representative came and took a piece of the shelving for comparison. The new shelving should be coming soon.

Shirley stated that some of the old history books will be sorted through and some disposed of as the shelves are full.

The meeting was adjourned.
