Librarian, Lois Kotas has been ordering new books as requested or by other recommendations. Lois will be contacting people who have overdue books.

Mary Johnson told about the Geneva Library having a big attendance and success with the puzzle contest.

Mary Uldrich made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Mary Johnson seconded the motion, the meeting was adjourned at 4:10.
