



Handmade, homemade and home grown products

The 2018 Milligan Farmers Market is in the planning stages and will be once again starting in June! With the surveys from last season, it was decided to change the start time this year. Please read the information below and you will be on your way to a stress-free, friendly and fruitful market!

Time/Location/Season: The Milligan Farmers Market is held on Sunday afternoons from 12:00-2:00 pm between 6th & Main Streets (across from the beer garden) in downtown Milligan. The season is June 17 until the vendors decided they are out of supplies!

Space Assignment: A vendor's space is first come first serve. Tents are permissible as long as they are confined to the 10' x 10' area. Vendors are responsible for providing their own tables and chairs. Once again, there is no charge for the space.

Product Guidelines: The Committee has determined that only **handmade, homemade, homegrown products** will be sold at the Farmers Market. If you would like to sell baked goods, it is recommended that you include the name/contact information, price of products (such as 3 cookies for \$2.00 or cookies-\$2.00 per pound) and a list of ingredients. Please have signage at your booth indicating whether your baked goods were prepared in a licensed kitchen or not. This needs to be visible at your booth at all times.

We will be using our facebook page (*Milligan Farmers Market*) to update the public on the Farmers Market. If you have any specials or introducing new produce or products, you can post your product or contact Taylor Slezak or Ronda Korbelik with that information by Thursday of each week.

Weather: The Farmers Market will go rain or shine. It is up to each vendor to decide if they are going to attend due to the weather.

Set-up/Parking: You will be able to park on the Main street or in the vendor area if needed, otherwise there is plenty of parking off of 6th & L Street. All vendors should be set up and ready to sell by 12:00 pm. To give all vendors an equal chance of making sales, **NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO MAKE ANY SALES BEFORE** the starting time. The Market goes until 2:00 pm, however, if you choose to stay longer, that is fine.
